Walkerton to Haiti Clean Water Project

Over the past three months a group of students led by Courtney Bushell and Bridget King have been fundraising to drill a well in Haiti in memory of the seven people who lost their lives and the thousands that were sickened during the Walkerton ecoli crisis, in time for the tenth anniversary celebrations. A number of fundraisers both in school and in the community including a penny race, popcorn sales, a BBQ, the collection of e-waste, the sale of rainbarrels, and "Bricks for Haiti" were held. The grand total of \$4288.65 was raised! That amount is enough to drill not only a well, but to also build a washroom in a Haitian community in need.



A cheque was presented to Teresa McLellan of Lifewater Canada, the Canadian based organization we purchased our well through. Teresa mentioned that she will be using our school as an example of how students can bring about positive change and she is thrilled with our success!

SHHS Graduation 2010

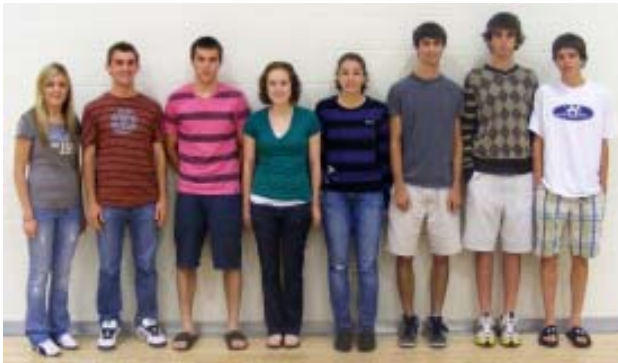
