EXAM SCHEDULE

Exams for first term will be held from Friday January 27th to Wednesday February 1st. Period 1 exams will be written on Day 1 (January 27th), Period 2 exams will be written on Day 2 (January 30th), Period 4 exams will be written on Day 3 (January 31st), and Period 5 exams will be written on Day 4 (February 1st). If any exam days are postponed due to weather cancellations, the postponed exams will be written on the next school day and the remaining exam schedule will be delayed by one day. Attendance for exams is mandatory. Please do not book any appointments on these dates.

Students are expected to write exams on the dates scheduled. In exceptional situations such as serious illness, extenuating circumstances, or death in the immediate family, students should notify the school as soon as possible and an alternate schedule may be arranged. Students must provide medical certificates (a doctor's note) for absences due to illness.

Busses will run at normal times on exam days. Students may wish to make alternate arrangements for rides if they do not wish to spend the entire day at the school. Students who are not writing an exam, but are at school, will be expected to use the time to study in the cafeteria or a classroom. Students are not required to come to school on exam days if they have no scheduled exams.

THE ONTARIO SECONDARY SCHOOL LITERACY TEST (OSSLT)

Students who are in Grade 10 (and those who did not successfully complete the test in previous years) will be writing the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test on March 29th, 2012. Students should be preparing in advance to ensure that they are successful on the test. Sample preparation materials/questions from previous tests can be found on the EQAO Web Site at <http://www.eqao.com>. Students should check out the type of questions that they will face on the test and practice such question types so that there are no surprises on the test. Successfully completing the Literacy Requirement is mandatory to receive your Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

A 5-session literacy test preparation course will be offered at Sacred Heart after-school in March if there is sufficient interest. Watch for more details in the February Newsletter.

MedQUEST

Health Career Exploration Camp

The MedQUEST Health Career Exploration Camp is scheduled to be held in Walkerton, July 9-13, 2012. Students who are currently in grades 10 and 11 are eligible to attend this interactive program. Medical students from the Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry will lead participants in a variety of activities that will illustrate the training required to work in the diverse fields of health care.



The call for online applications begins February 1, 2012. Acceptance is based on first come, first served. The online application process closes March 14. A maximum of 30 students from throughout the Grey-Bruce area will be accepted. Students and parents must complete the on-line application form. Confirmation of up-to-date immunizations and proof of a current 2-Step (Mantoux) Tuberculosis Status are required at the time of application. Successful applicants will be notified by March 30, 2012. There is a \$200.00 administrative fee to attend MedQUEST. MedQUEST information and application form are available at www.medquestwestern.ca.
